



## LANGUAGE ARTS

UNIT THEME is **NEIGHBORHOOD**

Story for the week Russ and the Firehouse by Janet Elizabeth Rickert



- Letters for the week - Hh
  - Clapping words into syllables (word parts)
  - Onset rhyme - This activity is done without the children seeing the letters. The children hear and repeat the word parts to connect to a word.
  - Sound letter association
    - /h/ as in *hippo* at the beginning/initial and medial/middle of pictures and words
  - Segmenting and blending words with the /h/ sound
  - Letter formation using Handwriting Without Tears formation for the letter Hh
    - H = starting corner, big line down, lift, other corner, big line down, lift, little line across the middle, uppercase H
    - h = big line down, up, over, down and bump, lowercase h
- Comprehension Skill
  - Main Idea and details - what is the story about and what happens in the story to support the main idea
  - Classify and categorize
  - Sequence of events - what happens first, middle and last in the story
- High frequency word - said
  - *High frequency words are words that the children recognize immediately without using letter/sound association (sounding out). High frequency words taught to date include: a, I, can, go, see, the, am, like, we, to, have, is, play, are, for, you, this, do, and, little, said*

## MATHEMATICS

- Counting to 80 in March
- Chapter 3 - Numbers beyond 10
  - Vocabulary: set, digit, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, ten frame, extras
  - Count and create sets or groups of objects 11-20
  - Use ten frames to illustrate the numeral - the top row of the ten frame is colored red, the bottom row of the ten frame is colored yellow.



These two ten frames show the number 13. 13 is one ten frame and 3 extra.

*Please practice counting to 100 with your child.*
