## A small listing includes:

## **Working Directly with Students**

- ♦ Helping students in the Cafeterias, Classrooms, or Computer Labs
- ♦ Helping as a Tutor, Guest Reader or Speaker
- Listening to Children Read

## **Working in Support Areas**

- Playing Piano or Other Musical Instruments
- Assisting in Art, Library, Home Economics, or Science Labs

## **Working in Offices and Building Support**

- ♦ Doing Special Assignments Copying/Collating paperwork
- Assisting in Health Rooms, Library, Office, Typing, and Clerical

Participants have the opportunity to serve for up to 100 hours of service, in exchange for up to \$500 of reduction in School Property Taxes.

## Who is Eligible?

Any person who is at least 60 years of age, resides in Pottstown, and pays Pottstown property taxes.

## How do I Apply?

- An application can be picked up from the receptionist at the Administration Building, 230 Beech Street, or call 610-323-6984.
- The application must be completed and returned to the Administration Building's Personnel Office.
- Applicants will be screened and accepted on a "first come first served" basis. An individual's financial need may be considered should more citizens apply for this program than the Golden Sage budget has allocated.
- Applicants must also submit a request for Criminal Record Check, Child Abuse History Clearance, and Cogent Fingerprint Clearance. These laws assure that individuals with a history of child abuse do not have the opportunity to harm children again. The applicant is responsible for the \$10 fee for each of the first two clearances. The \$40 fee for the fingerprint clearance is reimbursed to the applicant upon qualifying with 40 volunteer hours.

### **Working Hours**

> The normal working hours for participants will be between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. However, this will depend upon the specific assignment. The person does not have to work a full 8 hour day but should be available for at least one hour assignments.

## **Minimum Hours Required**

Participants MUST commit to a minimum of 40 hours of time to receive any tax credit.

#### **Maximum Hours Available**

> The maximum number of hours an individual may receive tax credit for participation in the program is 100 hours of service a year. The rate of credit participants will receive is \$5 of credit for each hour of assistance they provide to the district.

## **Application of the Tax Credit**

➤ Upon completion of 40 hours of more (100 max.), participants will be given a credit voucher for the number of hours worked times \$5 per hour. At the time the participant pays his/her taxes, s/he will submit the voucher. The tax collector will subtract the amount of the voucher from the property tax bill. PLEAST NOTE: The tax credit voucher must be used during the subsequent tax year that the participant provided the assistance to the school. This tax credit may have Federal Income Tax implications.

## May I Apply Again for Another Year?

Yes. Individuals may apply as many years as they feel a desire to help.
