Hotspot Acceptance Form

This Hotspot Acceptance Form (the "Agreement") ensures that equipment supplied by Pottstown School District (the "District") will be used and maintained in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, by the student ("Student"). By signing this form, the student will demonstrate reasonable care with respect to the security and physical well-being of the equipment assigned to his/her care.

Your acceptance of a Hotspot acknowledges you read and understand:

1. Pottstown's School Board of Directors' Policy 815: Utilization of Technology
2. The equipment must be returned to the District in its original condition (reasonable wear and tear excepted, as determined exclusively by the District), at the end of the school year or when the student leaves the district if prior to the end of the school year.
3. The hotspot should only be used by current Pottstown School District students.
4. The district will monitor use of the hotspot for appropriate data usage. Devices may be restricted or revoked if there is excess or inappropriate use or any violations of district technology policies.
5. The district must be notified immediately should the device be damaged, lost or stolen.

I certify that the following student does not have sufficient internet access for remote learning when the student is not physically attending school.

- Sufficient Internet access refers to Internet connectivity that is reliable and enables the student to receive and send electronic information for homework and online classes.
- Remote learning includes off-campus educational activities while the student is not physically in a school building. Homework and virtual online classes are both part of remote learning.
