You may refer yourself or a friend by using a form you will find in the guidance office. Place it in the box in the guidance department or give the form to a SAP Team member. The SAP Team will act upon the information you provide by:

- a. gathering and verifying information which supports the referral
- b. contacting the parent or guardian
- c. referring the student to a licensed mental health or drug and alcohol treatment program or facility
- d. providing for in school or out of school counseling
- e. inclusion in support group
